

3. Fitting Procedure

Before starting this process, please ensure that the stove is cold and unlit





Figure 1. Fixing Locations

Step 1 : Working on the rear of the appliance, loosen the 2x screws (DO NOT REMOVE), as indicated in figure 1.




Figure 3. Heat Shield Location

Step 2: Lower & position the heat shield onto the 2no. protruding screws (See Fig. 2 & 3)

Step 3: Ensure that the heat shield is fully located onto the slot cut out within the heat shield (Both Sides - Left & Right).

Step 4 : Re-tighten the 2x mounting screws, via the circular cut out in the face of the heat shield. Use a screwdriver to tighten the screws. Thus clamping the heat shield to the rear of the appliance.




Figure 4. Rear Heat Shield Layout

Step 5: With the heat shield fitted (See Fig. 4.), please observe the revised distance to combustible materials, as stated in the instruction guide (BK 738).
